



NORMANDIE PARTICIPATIONS



Co-investment fund taking part in capital or quasi-equity in start-ups and SMEs with a head office in Normandy. The aim is to complete its equity the existing public financial tools: banks, BPI, AD Normandie, Réseau Entreprendre and business angels. Co-investment with private actors in each deal, with the same valorization and shareholders agreement "pari passu". Private actors have to invest 30% or more in the round.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Partnership with local actors of financing.
- Investment from 150k€ to 10M€: Seed Capital / Venture Capital Growth Capital / LBO Distressed investment
- Ability to be a long term partner for the companies they have invested in.





#INNOVATIVE



THE FIRST HYDROGEN REFIGERATED SEMI-TRAILER IS IN NORMANDY!



The Spanish-Norman company <u>CHEREAU</u>, which specializes in refrigerated bodies for heavy goods vehicles, has been putting its innovative hydrogen refrigerated semi-trailer on the road since the beginning of July 2019 for a test phase.

This is a product developed as part of the ROAD project. 5.5 million euros were required to complete this innovation. The Normandy Region, the Franche-Comté Region and the BPI France were also contributors on a financial part.

Partners have joined forces with CHEREAU, including Carrier and Tronico, the FCLAB Research Federation and the École nationale supérieure d'arts et métiers. A major project for a company with a turnover of €220 million and 1,000 employees. The prototype will be tested in real conditions by the Norman carrier Malherbe.



Additionally, the city of Rouen is getting ready for the arrival of ships from all over the world to sail up the River Seine during the 30th Rouen Armada, which is held once every four to six years and draws millions of spectators.
