All the members of the Grand Marché de Provence adhere to **seven principles**:


- **Promoting** responsible, high-quality agriculture, qualified and certified by specifications guaranteeing the origin of each product, from field to fork.

Agrucorse was established in 2006 by five passionate producers who are pioneers in the island's citrus farming. Located in Folelli, 30 km south of Bastia, they built a modern packaging facility in the IGP Clémentine Corse region. This facility is the largest and most recent of its kind. Agrucorse also has a warehouse and a commercial office on the mainland near Cavaillon, where all products are transited.

The company includes 32 producers managing 240 hectares of orchards, yielding 8,300 tonnes of fruits annually, including 7,000 tonnes of clementines, 1,000 tonnes of pomelos, and 300 tonnes of others citrus (oranges, lemons, limes and lemon caviar). They employ five permanent staff in Corsica and three on the mainland.
